

Last October 11th, la Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil and the Church of Latter Day Saints signed an Agreement to donate 1.115 wheelchairs and implements related to jointly carry through this humanitarian program to help children and adults with motor disability and in conditions of greater vulnerability.

Beneficiaries will be persons of scarce economic means and motor disability problems since they will be the ones to receive, free of charge, those wheelchairs that the Latter Day Saints Church will deliver to la Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil for its respective distribution.
