

A total of twenty persons belonging to the Hemiplegic, Paraplegic and Quadriplegic Associations in Guayas, received the same number of folding wheelchairs, thanks to a strategic alliance between La Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil (JBG) and the Jesus Crist Church of Latter Day Saints.

Betsabè Pilaloa, Asoplegic President, thanked those who made the delivery possible in the name of beneficiaries, "We knocked on a lot of doors, several steps were taken.
